Complementary and Integrative Health - Whole Health

Complementary generally means that the approach or treatment is used alongside traditional medical care. For example, an individual may be receiving both Exelon (Rivastigmine) and coconut oil . Alternative therapy is a term usually used when a treatment is used in place of conventional medical care.
