Some basic rules for MLA Work Cited lists are: All citations should be double spaced. Indent after the first line of each entry (hanging indent) Entries are not numbered; Alphabetize by the first word of the entry. If no author is listed, begin with title.

Title Page: MLA style does not require a title page; instead, the first page of the paper should begin with four lines, double spaced, indicating: your name, name of the course instructor, name of the course, and the date. Spacing: Double-space every line (including long quotes and the citations on the Works Cited page).

Note: If your instructor has his or her own requirements, follow them. These guidelines are the most commonly required. MLA Sample Paper Use Times New Roman or a similar font, 12 point in size with standard 2.54 cm (1 inch) margins. Avoid decorative fonts. Double-space throughout the essay, including for block quotations and the list of works cited.

Use Times New Roman, twelve point font. Again, this is a basic rule for MLA format – probably the most basic, actually. Also, note that you need to make sure that your entire paper uses Times New Roman.

General rules for each MLA in-text citation: It should correspond to its relevant reference from the works cited page. Every citation should contain the author's last name and the page (or range of pages) where the specific quote or information is found in the original source.

To cite a source, the last name of the author (or the title of the article in quotation marks if no author is named) and the page number are used in sentences that contain a quote, paraphrasing, or a summary.
